-Lisa Curtis, Chair – Call to Order

-Motion to add Public Comment to Agendas going forward and to today's Agenda – passed unanimously.

-Review and approval of Minutes from May 12, 2021 Meeting. Motion to approve the Minutes – passed unanimously.

-Report of Charlotte Madueno, Executive Director – Thank you for opportunity to advocate for the women of this state that I love. Now set up with state email, equipment, etc. Looking at options for consultant re: website design and social medial outreach, as well as the maintenance of both. Twitter, Facebook. YouTube all set up. Has spoken to a videographer for making videos for 4 quadrants to promote upcoming listening tour. Looking at potentially having listening tour dates very soon to correspond with the NM Citizen Redistricting Committee dates. Working with Jeremy Farris from the State Ethics Commission and he has really helped with the process.

-Additional comment by Lisa Curtis, Chair - Statewide listening tour dates are potential dates that piggyback on the CRC dates. Opportunity to get data right away for the report due to the Governor in December per statute. Have opportunity to take advantage of the path (dates & locations) prepared by these other two commissions. Another benefit is to get women out to be involved in the redistricting discussions. These are quadrant-based meetings and Commissioners from those areas are expected to help determine methods of outreach, and then will do talking and running of meetings. Good idea to spread resources out. Dates and locations are also on the budget as well as money for meeting transportation, snacks/refreshments, childcare, etc. Goal is to bring in as many women as possible, including the outlying rural areas.

-Member discussion on suggested dates, methods of outreach, budget, scheduling time constraints, and success rates. Will discuss further at strategic planning meeting.

-Budget review by Ms. Madueno.

-Motion to approve budget - passed unanimously.

-Partnerships with NM organizations. Member listed numerous organizations across the state that may be good resources in having successful public meetings.

-Comments from the public

Julianna Koob – plans to attend future meetings, has worked with Ms. Madueno in the past, and congratulations on getting an incredible Executive Director. Ms. Koob has worked for the protection of women against domestic violence and sexual assault for 30 years. Strongly suggests using data from the coalitions/organizations that have already been collecting for 10-15 years. Hopes the Commission will prioritize the Paid Family Leave Act and sexual violence prevention funding.
